- Place filter in a plastic bucket, preferable outside.
- Spray the Instant Filter Spray evenly over filter.
- Leave in-situ for 15 minutes.
- Thoroughly rinse off
- Return filter to spa or hot tub.

P406 – Store in a corrosion resistant container with a resistant inner liner.
